PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Dear Members and Supporters,

It is my privilege to present the 14th Annual Report for Swimming Metro North East (SMNE) for the year 2022/2023. As we reflect on the challenges and achievements of the past year, I would like to take this opportunity to highlight the significant initiatives and accomplishments that have shaped our organization.

Continued Coach Development:

Building on the success of the previous year's coach development webinars, SMNE continued to invest in the growth and professional development of our coaching staff. Increasing coach payments for involvement in development activities. We also set up systems by which coaches will be able to receive funding to support their professional development. Moving forward we will also be providing our coaches with more opportunities to be supported by SMNE to travel and gain additional experiences with travel meets. These initiatives aimed to enhance the skills and knowledge of our coaches, enabling them to provide the highest level of guidance and support to our athletes. We are proud of the commitment shown by our coaching community in their pursuit of excellence.

Enhancing Support for Volunteers:

Volunteers are the backbone of our organization, and their contributions are immeasurable. In line with our commitment to recognizing and appreciating their efforts, SMNE implemented several initiatives to enhance the support provided to our volunteers. We expanded our technical official allowance policy, ensuring that officials are reimbursed for their expenses when providing services at SMNE sanctioned events. The streamlining of sign-up systems and digitising the reimbursement we have made the extra chores involved with being an official in SMNE that much easier. This, along with an improved positive culture among our officials has seen those volunteer numbers greatly increase in the last twelve months. Their selfless dedication has been instrumental in the success of our meets and the growth of our organization.

Performance at National Level:

Congratulations to all our members who competed at the national level in the past 12 months. As a region, we had 39 swimmers participating in the Australian Championships and 107 swimmers at the Australian Age Championships. Among the Australian Age Championships, two of our clubs, Knox/Pymble (5th place) and Warringah (10th place), achieved positions in the top 25 in Australia, accounting for 50% of the NSW Clubs in the top 10. I am excited to see this growth continue in the future.

Growing Athlete Support:

At SMNE, we believe in providing comprehensive support to our athletes. In line with this commitment, we have strengthened our athlete support programs, with our vision of supporting our athletes with services and experiences in future years. The increase budget directed towards development support and opportunities to take effect in the near future. With a plan to have a

positive impact with these initiatives on our athletes' performance and well-being. We remain dedicated to continually improving our support systems.

Community Engagement and Growth:

Having navigated through the pandemic and finding ourselves on the other side, with our first uninterrupted year since 2020, our membership numbers have continued to increase. We are proud to have moved from just shy of 2000 members last year, to a robust 2230 members at the writing of this report who demonstrate a passion for swimming and a commitment to our organization. We believe that swimming holds a special place within our community, and we are focused on expanding our reach and engaging more individuals in the sport. Our goal is to inspire and nurture the next generation of swimmers, fostering a love for swimming and promoting a healthy and active lifestyle.

Looking Ahead:

As we move forward, we are excited about the future of SMNE. We will continue to navigate the challenges presented to us and adapt to changing circumstances, ensuring the success of our members. We remain committed to providing our athletes with the best possible support, developing our coaching staff, and recognizing the invaluable contributions of our volunteers. I extend my heartfelt appreciation to the entire SMNE community, including our athletes, coaches, volunteers, parents, and supporters. Your dedication, passion, and unwavering support are the driving forces behind our success. COMPETITIONS REPORT

2022/2023 REPORTING YEAR

The swimming world was uninterrupted this year with no pandemic shutting any meets down in the 2022-23 reporting year. SMNE proceeded to run our usual meets which included the Winter and Summer Area Championships, Speedo Sprint Heats and SC and LC Distance meets. In addition, we were able to offer a Time Trial Mini meet of 200m events for swimmers without a QT. This was run immediately prior to the Winter championships which saw 85 swimmers' race, many of them obtaining a State or Metro qualifying time.

Our meets this year resulted in the following numbers:

Jun 2022 – Winter Champs: 486 Athletes, 2140 Events, \$10218 profit (up from 2021)
Jun 2022 – SC Distance Meet: 181 Athletes, 292 Entries, \$191 profit (down from 2021)
Oct 2022 – LC Distance Meet: 223 Athletes, 344 Events, \$173 loss (down from 2021)
Nov 2022 – Summer Champs: 517 Athletes, 2255 Events, \$11444 profit (up from 2021)
Feb 2023 – Speedo Heats/13U: 434 Athletes, 1832 Events, \$3450 profit (down from 2022)

The overall profit with all the meets combined was ~\$25000, an overall increase of around \$5000 from 2021/22. Pool fees and catering costs have again increased this year and the recommendation is to increase the race entry fees to \$12 for individual events with relay entry fees remaining at \$15 each. These fees are still significantly cheaper than State and National entry fees.

Willoughby Swim Club and North Sydney Swim Club are currently inactive due to pool renovations. Monte remains inactive, choosing to exist strictly for school competitions and a new Club was formed – Shore Swim Club, operating out of Shore School.

Within our Area, 46 Club meets and 14 Inter-Club meets were approved for official results in the 2022-23 year compared with 41 Club and 8 Inter-Club events in the previous year.

Two Clubs in our Area qualified in the Top 10 Clubs at Age Nationals in April 2022 – Knox Pymble (5th) and Warringah Aquatic (10th).

DEVELOPMENT REPORT

In 2022 we saw a return to SMNE development squads for all levels A, B, C & D squads undertook clinics focused on swimming faster freestyle and form strokes, with James Magnussen. I would like to express thanks to David Beck for all his work as Development Convenor.

With a new Development Coordinator appointed in 2023 we have seen fresh ideas and new opportunities provided to our area's swimmers.

Thanks to the boards support - the area is proudly investing in the High Performance area with National prep clinics held for both our Age and Open National Representatives to work on skills and build area comradery. The SMNE board has also greatly invested in highly subsidised Massage Therapists at National level meets and have received astoundingly positive feedback from swimmers and coaches.

With a hole in the SNSW pathway identified around Open athletes SMNE is working to provide opportunities to supporting these athletes, hoping to achieve greater retention of athletes in future years.

Moving forward SMNE Development will aim to provide a development clinic and competition opportunity to all squads in the Area development system each year as well as look to supporting athletes that are unaccounted for in the SNSW area guide in the most sustainable way.

Cost to Swimmers and SMNE

Thanks to SMNE support, athlete cost has remained at a minimum, all activities have had a level of payment from participants to ensure there is a perceived value of the activity and to reduce no-shows.

The cost of National massage has worked on a 50-50 approach to ensure cost is kept low with SMNE to cover the difference. Pricing has been \$10-\$15 an appointment.

National Clinics - SMNE has negotiated pool entry to received favourable rates for athletes, covered pool hire and coaching payments.

Coaching payments went up to \$100phr.

ATSC REPORT

I am pleased to provide the Area Technical Swimming Committee Convenor's Report, my first since I was elected to the role last year following my appointment to the Board of SMNE.

This is a role I have very much enjoyed and that is largely a result of working with such a friendly, dedicated and professional group of technical officials.

Therefore, it is very important that I begin by expressing my sincere thanks to the many volunteer technical officials who work tirelessly at our meets. They ensure our swimmers are able to compete at competitive meets that are facilitated in an efficient and fair manner.

As is always said, these meets simply cannot occur without their involvement. I know how much their time is appreciated by our swimmers, parents and coaches. So again, thank you!

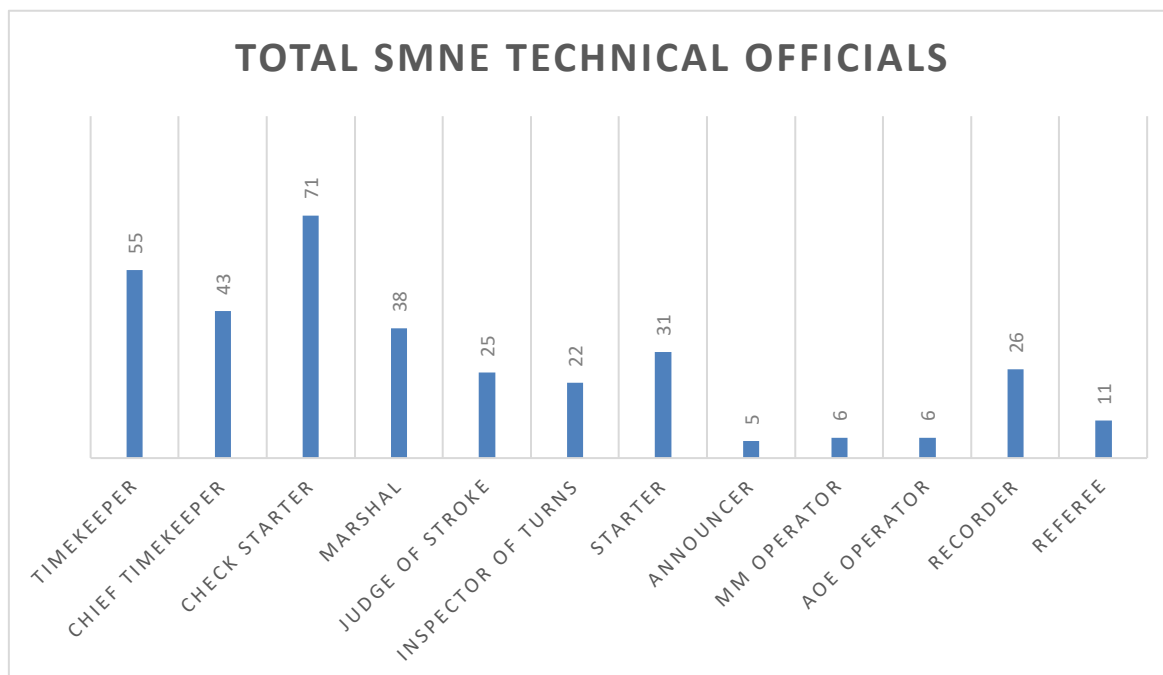
I would also like to express my gratitude to the members of your Area Technical Swimming Committee (ATSC), who support me in my role: Jerome Lagonilla (Warringah Aquatic), Matthew Paterson (Manly) and Dean Vince (Ravenswood).

When the four of us convened for the first time, we agreed our initial primary objective would be to identify the Area's active technical officials. We needed to determine where we had an abundance or deficiency of accreditations (e.g., check starter, recorder, judge of stroke).

We knew this would be vital to setting our future focus in the areas of training and assessment.

Furthermore, this process was important because we inherited a list of technical officials that included around 40 individuals whose technical official accreditation had expired. As most would know, officials are required to undergo a reaccreditation process every four years.

I am pleased to report that, following this process, we now have no 'expired' technical officials on our list. This will make the reaccreditation process much simpler in the future. As of June 2023, SMNE has 97 accredited technical officials with over 300 accreditations.



As you will note, the Area remains short of technical officials in the more 'technical' positions on pool deck, including Judge of Stroke, Inspector of Turns, MM Operator, AOE Operator and most importantly, Referee.

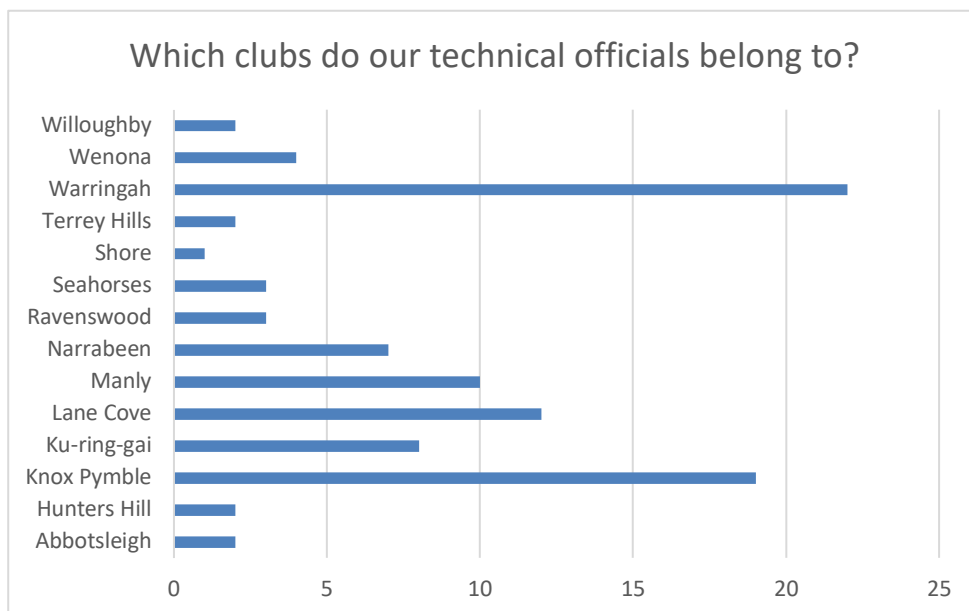
The good news is, we are working to increase these numbers! For example, at our recent Winter Championships, seven technical officials were given the opportunity to gain valuable practical experience as Inspectors of Turns.

Thanks to our assessors, 32 assessments have been completed over the past 12 months, resulting in an additional six Timekeepers, two Chief Timekeepers, eight Check Starters, four Marshals, two Judges of Stroke, two Inspectors of Turns, four Starters, two Meet Manager Operators, one Recorder and one Referee.

In particular, I wish to congratulate Heidi Roche (Ku-ring-gai) on becoming a L1 Referee. This follows extensive theory training and two successful Referee assessments. Well done, Heidi!

Pleasingly, I expect the Area to have three more Referees by this time next year. Dean, Matt and I are all in various stages of 'referee training' and look forward to gaining that accreditation.

Readers of this report may be interested to know how many technical officials are being provided from each of the clubs in our Area. They should refer to the diagram below:



Both the SMNE Board and the ATSC are eager to invest more in our technical officials. During the past 12 months this has included:

- Continuation of the popular 'technical official allowance scheme';
- The 2023 Country Regionals Initiative; and
- Distribution of complimentary hard copies of The Rules of Swimming to Referees and Judges of Stroke in our Area.

Dean, Matt and I have additional ideas we hope to propose to the Board of SMNE, but if anyone has any suggestions of their own, we would be very happy to hear from you. Once again and on behalf of the SMNE Board and the ATSC, I express our huge thanks to all of our technical officials for their work and support.

TREASURERS REPORT

Treasurer's Report for 31 March 2023

Profit and loss for 31 March 2023 is \$4,400.91 which is slightly higher than 31 March 2022.

Trading Income this year is \$80,765.42 up from last year's \$62,768.78. The major categories impacting this increase are Carnival Income and Development Entries.

Carnival Income this year \$69,426.84 up from last year on \$56,935.58.

Development Income Entries are up this year \$6,040.24 compared with nil last year. Due to the Development Squads held in June.

Cost of Sales was higher than last year \$64,929.89 this year \$48,178.59 with cost to run development squads \$11,000.00 compared with nil from previous year along with the venue hire (\$4,126.00) to run the development squads.

Operating Expenses were marginally higher than last year \$11,434.62 this year and \$10,249.96 last year.

The Total Equity/ Net Assets total \$148,249.81 which increased from the previous year of \$143,848.90. This is largely due to the increase in stock held (\$12,073.66 this year from \$2,586.57 previous year) less decrease in cash held \$146,345.64 this year down from \$150,915.32 previous year and increase in Sundry Creditors \$12,400 this year up from \$10,600 last year.

I am pleased to report that SMNE is in a healthy financial position and is able to meet its debts as and when they fall due.
